

NOTES

1. This licence must be produced on demand to a Justice of the Peace or Constable.
2. If the holder of this licence is authorised to sell spirits, he must, when he sends out spirits from his stock at his licensed premises to the place of occasional sale, prepare a spirits consignment note which may be retained at his licensed premises. It must be produced there to an Officer of the Customs and Excise in request at any time during the next twelve months.
3. Directions governing the preparation and retention of spirits consignment notes are contained in Customs and Excise Note No. 62 a copy of which may be obtained from any Customs and Excise Office.
